## RONNIE MABRA NAMED TO GEORGIA TECH BLACK ALUMNI GROUP'S "LEADERS AND LEGENDS"

The high-profile Atlanta personal injury lawyer was honored for his philanthropic works

**ATLANTA, APRIL 6, 2022** – Ronnie Mabra, managing partner of Mabra Law, was named one of eight "Leaders & Legends" by Georgia Tech's Black Alumni Organization (GTBAO). Selected in appreciation for his philanthropic works, the Atlanta native was honored during a 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary awards ceremony on April 1. The event kicked off a weekend of activities that recognized the six decades since Black students were first admitted to the university.

An ACC-All Academic student athlete, Mabra was a defensive back for the Yellow Jackets during his four years at Georgia Tech. After earning a bachelor's degree in management in 2000, he earned his J.D. from the University of Georgia School of Law.

The Leaders and Legends chosen this year "celebrate the collective successes of Black students, alumni, faculty, and staff of the Institute," according to a GTBAO statement. To commemorate those 60 years, GTBAO is recording historical narratives and compiling a digital yearbook for all Georgia Tech Black Alumni.

"I have always been proud of my education and my affiliation with Georgia Tech," said Mabra. "I was honored and humbled to be acknowledged in this way and at this time in our history."
